The social work profession shares a close relationship with human rights, because it adheres to values such as respect, dignity, and self-determination - values that are strongly embedded in the code of ethics for all practitioners. The Master's Programme in Social Work and Human Rights is shared by the Department of Social Work and the Department of Global Studies. It is one of the most applied for international master's programmes at the University of Gothenburg. It is a full-time (120 ECTS) programme, accessible for both international and Swedish students. Social workers take pride in their commitment to social and economic justice, peace, and human rights, and in their responses to related inequalities and social problems. Social Work and Human Rights has become a standard text highlighting the role of social work in protecting the rights of vulnerable populations.
